From SSF's working group for roller skis' recommendations:

We recommend that as an organizer you only approve wheels that have some type of printed marking on the wheels. This is to avoid discussions with the riders regarding the approval as an organizer. There are wheels that are completely unmarked, but these usually have a few years on the neck, for several years now all serious roller ski manufacturers have clear markings on the wheels that show what rolling resistance they have.

In the list below are all approved wheels from each manufacturer. For example, under Swenor it says 2, 3 or 4. Normal standard wheels are then marked with "2", then there are slower wheels called 3 or 4, they go slower, but they are also approved for competition.

More brands than those below may be added as time goes by.
